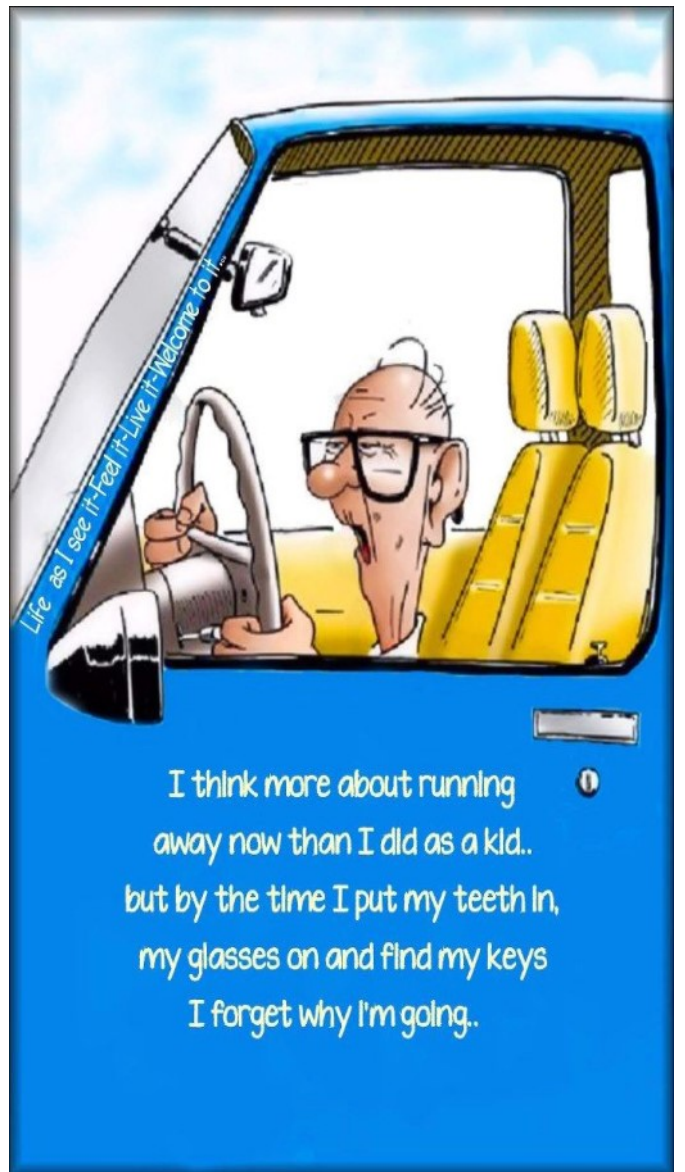

The magnetic **Good Morning** signs placed on the hallway side of your door lets us know that everything is good in your home. Please put them out by 10 am.

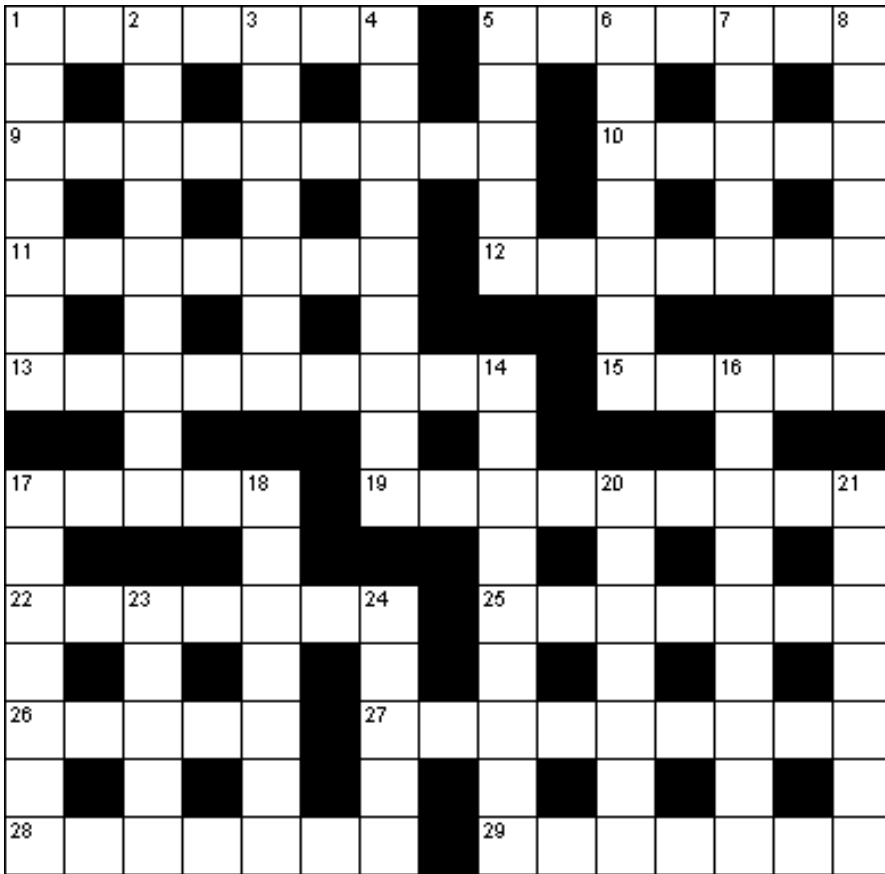
