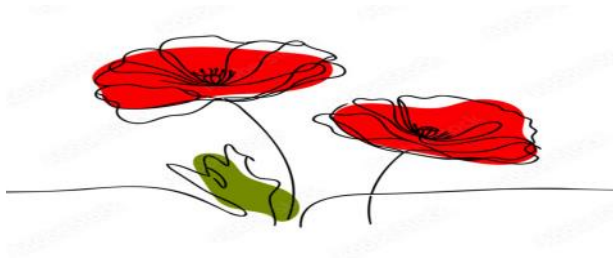

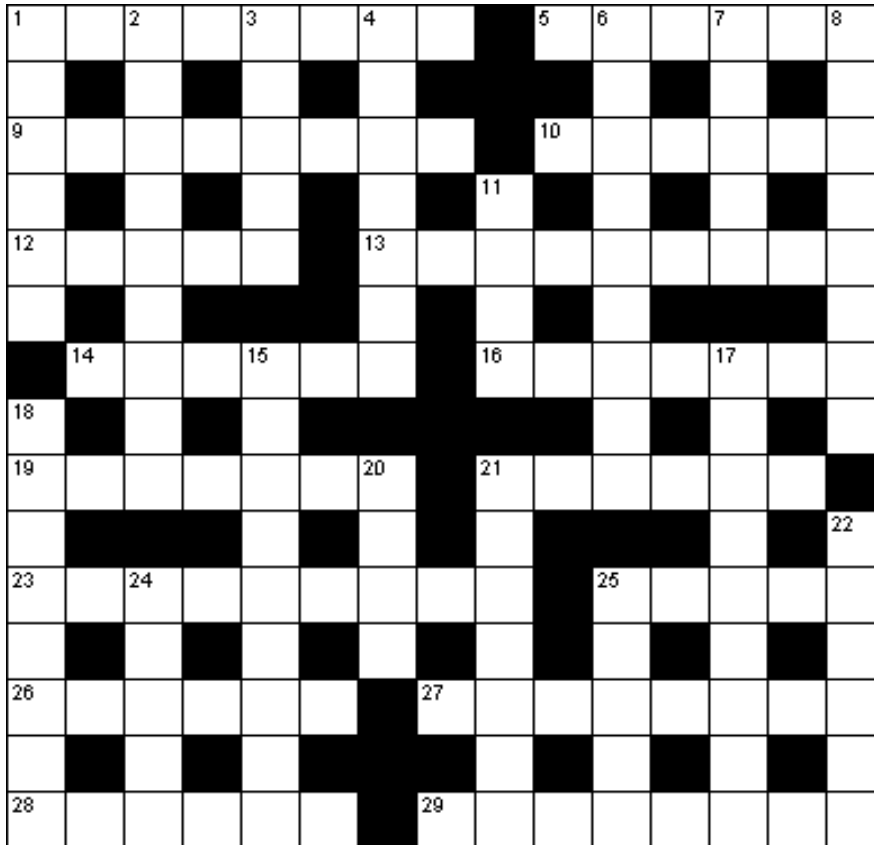

The magnetic **Good Morning** signs placed on the hallway side of your door lets us know that everything is good in your home. Please put them out by 10 am.



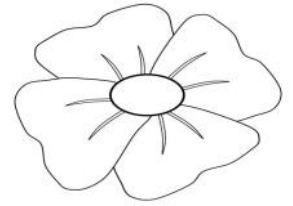

They'll hear our pipes no more.

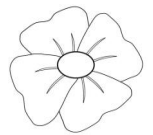
They are marching to Valhalla,  
On a far and distant shore.

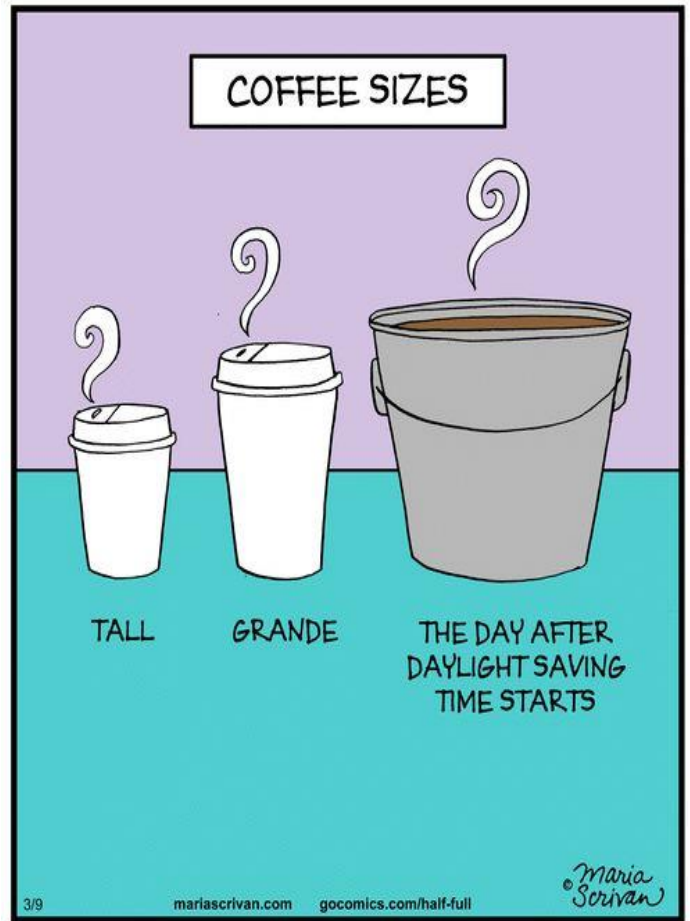
They'll rest there in Valhalla,
